In October of 2013, I was privileged to go to Zimbabwe for a conference with Bro. Riggen. The reports from previous trips were exciting to hear and the possibilities we felt in prayer were encouraging.

About 300 ministers and wives gathered for the conference. Most of them would be considered trinitarian Pentecostal, believing in the infilling of the Holy Ghost but having no revelation of Oneness or of Jesus' Name baptism. We went in the assurance that God was in this effort. Several elders had given us encouragement through prophetic words.

On the second day, Bro. Riggen started teaching on the Oneness of God. The presence of the Almighty descended into that room and revelation hit like a tidal wave! It was one of the most amazing things I've ever seen. People got to their feet, rejoicing and "amening" the preacher! A room of darkness saw a great light and many were baptized!

I have seen these men and their churches embrace Oneness, Jesus' Name baptism, and holiness. Even their members are testifying of the incredible presence of God they are seeing through their obedience to the revelation.
